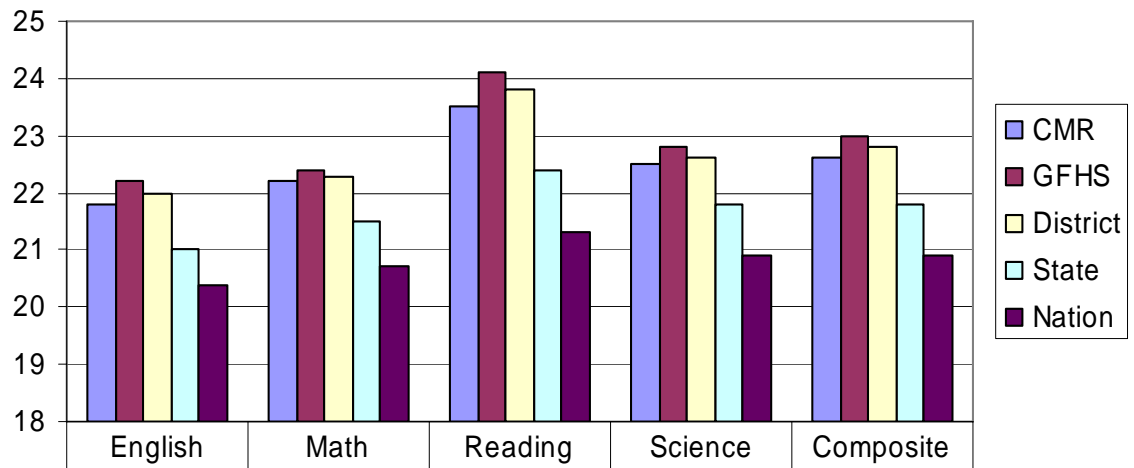


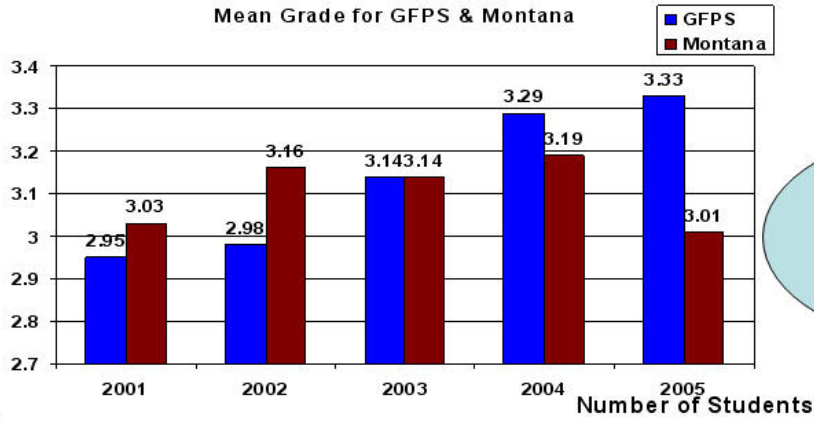

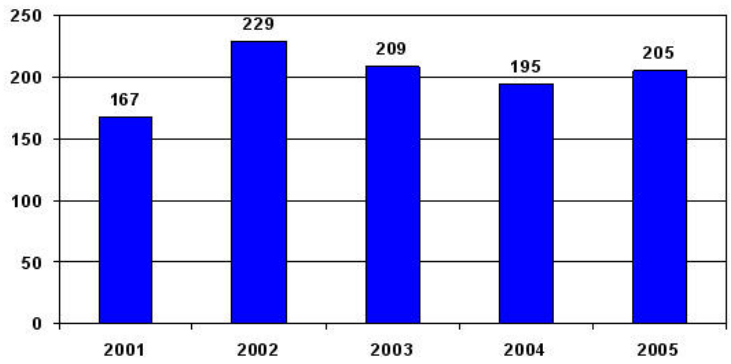

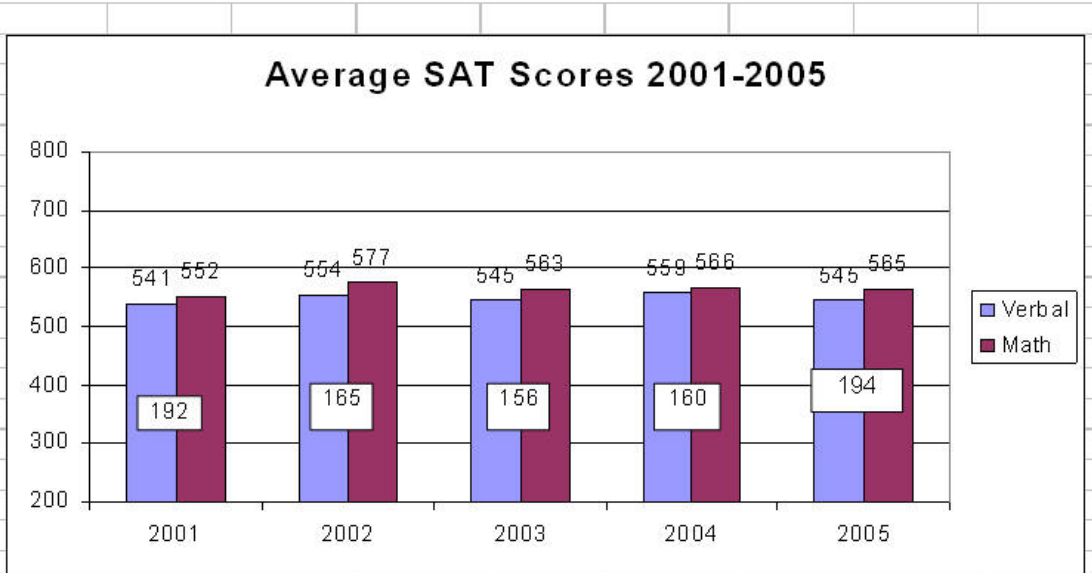

Mean Grade for GFPS & Montana

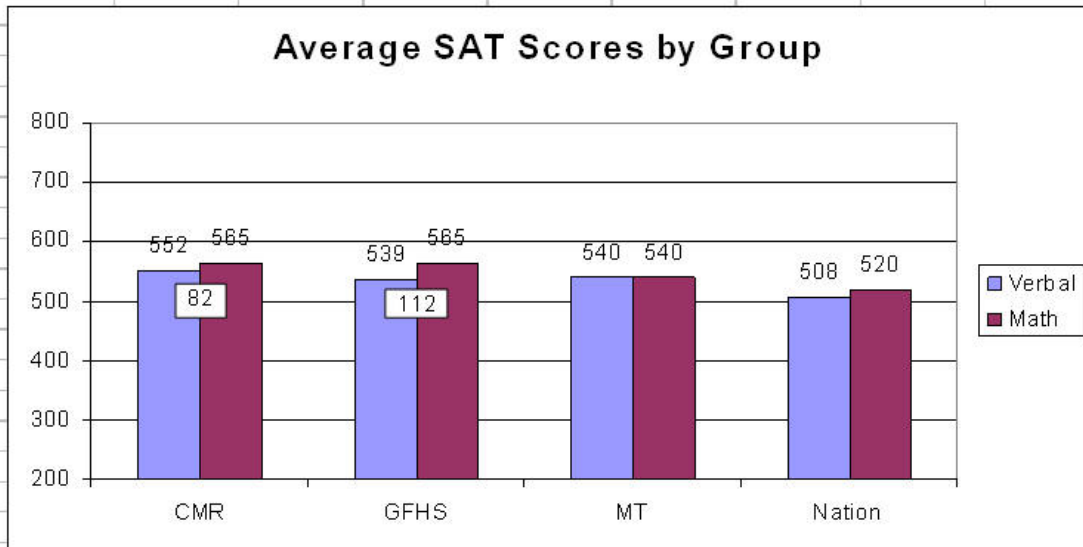


The number of GFPS students taking the AP exams has remained stable while the average score has increased above the State average score.





SAT reports that more than half of schools experience mean (average) score changes of at least 10 points from one year to the next. The five year trend indicates that our verbal scores have experienced a + 4 and our math scores have experienced a +13 mean score.



Nearly 1.5 million students in the class of 2005, representing 49% of the graduating class took the SAT. This is the first year of the new SAT test which includes a writing section.
