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Roosevelt Student Planning Day

What: On March 30th from 1:00-3:00 district personnel and classroom teachers will be working with grades 3-6 to include and engage students in the planning of the new Roosevelt placement school.

Students will become ambassadors of each area of planning: cafeteria/gym/lunch; playground/outside; classrooms/makerspace/breakout rooms; music/art/library. Students will be working in the classrooms prior to the event to learn about architectural vocabulary and compile their ideas for wants and needs.

Activities in the gym will include mini lessons on components of architecture, blue prints, floor plans, graphing and tracing paper, and reviewing classroom ideas. Students will then work with the architects from L'Heureux Page Werner Architecture to draw out their ideas.
