### **Boundary Adjustment Process – Community Information Meeting**

**What:** The Great Falls Public Schools (GFPS) is beginning a boundary adjustment. GFPS has hired a consultant with expertise in developing boundary adjustment studies, who will be facilitating the entire process. Public engagement and transparency are at the core of the process, and the public will have the opportunity to follow progress as the study continues. The purpose of the boundary adjustment process is to evaluate the boundaries of elementary schools within GFPS, and to make adjustments to account for new school openings along with addressing any imbalances in school utilization.

To kick off the process, the public is invited to attend a public information session on September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 at 7pm, located at the GFPS District Office Building (1100 4th St South, Great Falls, MT 59405).
