NeighborWorks Great Falls joined forces with Great Falls Public Schools to create the program, which provides new homes for residents with low or moderate incomes and gives high school students valuable employment skills. The students provide the labor while NeighborWorks supplies the lot, arranges subcontractors, and finances the construction. NWGF also works with potential homebuyers to get them mortgage-ready with homebuyer education and individual homeownership planning.
